Each classroom will have a themed basket on display for silent auction bidding. Here are some of the baskets that you will find available:

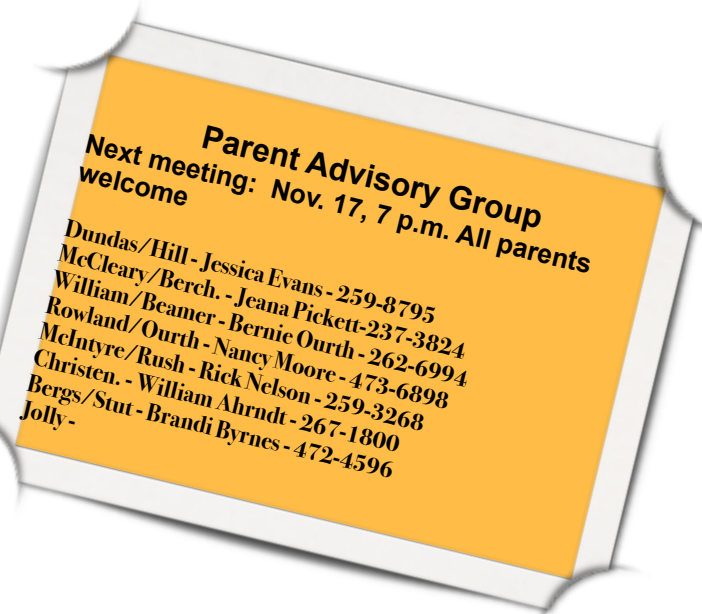

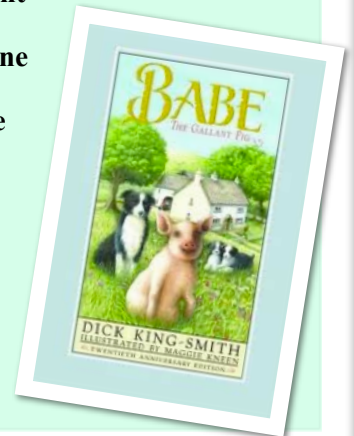
Keep saving BoxTops for Education. PTO will provide pizza lunch for the class that brings in the most boxtops each quarter.
