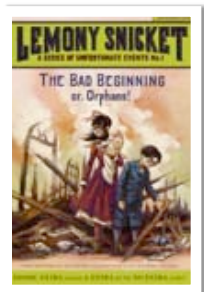
## The Park School Family Book Group

## Concussion Facts

- \*All concussions are serious.
- \*Most concussions occur without loss of consciousness.
- \*Recognition and proper response to concussions when they first occur can help aid recovery and prevent further injury, or even death.
- \*Children and adolescents are among those at greatest risk for concussion.

## Observable Signs/Symptoms

Appears dazed or stunned, is confused about events, answers questions slowly, repeats questions, can't recall events prior or after the hit, bump or fall, shows behavior/ personality changes
