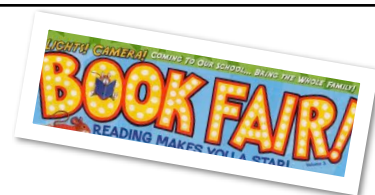

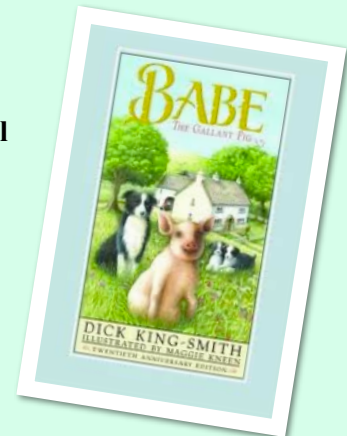
Girl Scout Troop 1155 Community Service Project
