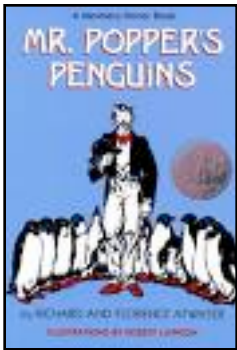


Park Parent News
