## Online Enrollment

If you have a child entering kindergarten, moving to 6th or 9th grade, you need to go online before January 31 and register your preference for which schools you would like your child to attend. Students with siblings at their first choice school will have preference for acceptance into that school. This preference only applies through the online

enrollment period. A neighborhood preference will also apply during this online enrollment period. This is not a time sensitive choice, but is done by lottery after January 31. Be sure to check the sibling box to give you priority if you already have children enrolled in Park School. Go to [www.natronaschools.org](http://www.natronaschools.org) for more information. 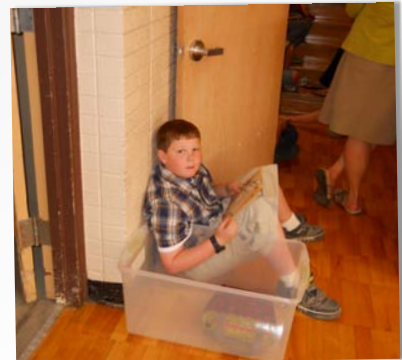
