



The staff of the Wyoming Veterans' Memorial Museum can assist you in teaching and telling military history and stories of local, state and national significance.

Our galleries are filled with stories of World War I, World War II, Korean War, Desert Storm, Iraq and Afghanistan. A special exhibit, Honoring a Generation's Sacrifice, will run through spring 2012. More than 20 candid and personal stories that bookend the Vietnam War from 1955-1975 let students understand what our servicemen and women were doing in Vietnam.

How Casper participated in bringing about the end of World War II is a powerful historic theme. The history of the busy World War II Casper Army Air Base comes alive with in-depth tours at the historic site.

Tours are available from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Friday. Hands-on opportunities are available as well as interactive sessions with Veterans. We can also come into the classroom.
